Is the birth registered in New Zealand?

If the birth is registered overseas you need to order your certificate from that country.

Are you ordering this certificate for your new baby?

If you have not yet registered the birth of your baby, you can register the birth and apply for a birth certificate at the same time at <u>smartstart.services.govt.nz</u>.

If you have already registered the birth, you can order a birth certificate at any time at govt.nz/bdm.

Do you want to use the certificate outside New Zealand?

When you need to use a New Zealand certificate in another country, you might be asked to get the document apostilled or authenticated. Apostilles and authentications are certificates that prove the signature, stamp or seal on a document is genuine.

If you want to use the certificate overseas, go to govt.nz/authentications to find out more information.

Do you need a certificate or a copy of the record?

You can order a certificate or a copy of the record. A certificate is a legal official document. A copy of the record contains more information than a certificate and is usually used for research purposes.

Are you researching family history?

If you want to order a certificate or a copy of the record for a historical birth, you can do this at bdmhistoricalrecords.dia.govt.nz.

A historical birth is:

- the birth (excluding a stillbirth) of:
 - a deceased person who died 50 years ago or more, or
 - a deceased person who was born 80 years ago or more, or
 - a living person who was born 100 years ago or more
- a stillbirth that occurred 50 years ago or more.

Are you adopted and want your original birth certificate?

If you are adopted and you were born or adopted in New Zealand, once you turn 20 years old you can request your original (pre-adoptive) birth certificate. To do this, you need to complete a different form (BDM451 Request for pre-adoptive New Zealand birth certificate).
